Best Prospects

- Casual AMSOIL supporters who have a favorable opinion of AMSOIL and may consider using AMSOIL products, but warranty fears stand in the way.
- Enthusiasts who resent feeling strong-armed into buying the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) brand of parts and lubricants to avoid losing their new-snowmobile warranty. They don't like paying a premium for OEM parts and lubricants and will consider using AMSOIL products, but warranty fears present an obstacle.
- Enthusiasts who aren't loyal to the OEM, who are undecided about which oil to use or who are new to the sport.

Converting Target Buyers to Customers

Resist the temptation to make recommendations and tout technical features before you understand the buyer and have gained his or her trust. For best results, use your experience helping current customers to guide your conversation.





Briefly introduce yourself and the AMSOIL brand. Ask about the prospect's sled and where he or she likes to ride. Ask questions that jump-start the conversation and help you uncover the prospect's buying motivations.

- Where do you typically ride?
- How many miles per season do you ride?
- Do you perform your own maintenance?
- How often do you buy a new sled?
- Do you use the manufacturer's products or are you open to aftermarket products?



In this phase, you and the prospect work together to discover whether he or she has a need for AMSOIL products. Ask open-ended questions that steer the conversation toward problems he or she might be experiencing.

- Many riders believe they should be able to use the free market to choose the best lubricants for their sled, and they don't like being told they have to buy the OEM's oil or risk losing their warranty. What's your thinking on this?
- Riders often think they have to buy the OEM oil to maintain their new-sled warranty. They're sometimes surprised to hear that tying warranty coverage to use of the OEM oil is illegal in America. Have you had a similar experience?
- Do you ever have problems with excessive smoke or plugs fouling? (Two-stroke sleds.)
- How often do you clean the power valves in your sled? (Two-stroke sleds.)

Understanding OEM Warranty Coverage

The following chart summarizes original equipment manufacturer (OEM) warranty-coverage levels. OEMs often offer additional coverage during spring promotions on new-model-year sleds. The AMSOIL Runs On Freedom™ Limited Snowmobile Warranty offers riders a strong competitive choice to OEM warranties, and AMSOIL offers a more generous sign-up period of 18 months. Runs on Freedom™ Limited Snowmobile Warranty Frequently Asked Questions

Who's eligible for the warranty? The AMSOIL Runs on Freedom Limited Snowmobile Warranty is available to enthusiasts who purchase a current-model-year or newer two-stroke snowmobile directly from an authorized dealership. Pre-owned snowmobiles and dealership hold-overs do not qualify.

What does the Runs on Freedom Limited Snowmobile Warranty cover? See the Runs on Freedom Limited Snowmobile Warranty terms and conditions at AMSOIL.com/lander/snow-warranty/terms.aspx (AMSOIL.ca/lander/snow-warranty/terms.aspx in Canada).

What is the duration of the warranty? Two years from the date you take physical delivery of the snowmobile or 5,000 miles (8,000 km), whichever comes first.

Do I have to sign up for the warranty immediately after buying my snowmobile? No. For example, the warranty period lasts two years/24 months from the date you took physical delivery of the snowmobile. AMSOIL is allowing up to 18 months from the date you took physical delivery of the snowmobile to enroll in this warranty, which would leave you with 6 months of warranty coverage.

Do I need to use AMSOIL INTERCEPTOR® Synthetic 2-Stroke Oil throughout the warranty term? Yes. AMSOIL INTERCEPTOR must be used for the duration of warranty coverage.

Do other AMSOIL synthetic snowmobile oils qualify for the warranty? No. AMSOIL INTERCEPTOR Synthetic 2-Stroke Oil is the only qualifying oil.

How do I file a warranty claim? Obtain a copy of the repair estimate from the authorized original equipment manufacturer (OEM) dealership that performed the engine diagnostics and send it to AMSOIL INC. at rofwarranty@AMSOIL.com.

Do I need to supply an oil sample to AMSOIL for inspection prior to receiving warranty payment? No. Simply send us the estimate from the authorized OEM dealership and we'll confirm you're a registered participant who has been purchasing INTERCEPTOR Synthetic 2-Stroke Oil.

How do I register for the Runs on Freedom Limited Snowmobile Warranty? Visit AMSOIL.com/rofwarranty (AMSOIL.ca/rofwarranty in Canada), complete the registration form by following the "Register Now" button and we'll contact you to confirm eligibility.
