Surcharge Program Effective May 1

Although AMSOIL was forced to implement a price increase on March 1, the company has since received yet another round of large increases in the costs of raw materials and other materials used in the production of AMSOIL products. Bottles, packaging, hard parts, etc. are all being affected by the trickle-down effect from the rising cost of oil. Freight surcharges that impact nearly everything are rising dramatically as well. Due to the volatile and unpredictable nature of the market at this time, AMSOIL implemented a surcharge program in the U.S. and Puerto Rico as a temporary solution for recovering spiraling costs. As of May 1, prices of all AMSOIL products reflected an extra 5 percent surcharge across all programs in the U.S. Effective June 1, prices of all AMSOIL products will reflect an extra 3 to 5 percent surcharge in all programs in Canada as well. The exact percentage will be determined and announced at the end of May. Watch for an announcement at that time at www. amsoil.com. Until the market stabilizes, the surcharge will remain in place and may be adjusted on a monthly basis. New price lists will be printed once the market reaches some level of stability.
